

Driver Heavy Salvage IBKI Target group

and entry requirements.

This training is designed for anyone who performs salvage work on vehicles heavier than 3,500kg.

This course is designed as a continuation course after the "Driver Light Salvage" course.

The candidate must possess the "Driver Light Salvage" certificate, as well as at least 2 years of demonstrated experience.

Candidate must possess at least a valid C driver's license

The candidate holds the certificate 'REVI 1 and 2 (incident management)Or obtains this certificate during this training.

This course is a hands-on training course, given by very experienced salvagers who very expertly and enthusiastically impart the intricacies of this fine profession to the candidates
In this training a lot of attention is paid to safety, technique, roadside assistance and communication. This

entire training is in accordance with [Article 8 of the Working Conditions Decree](#) and the [Requirements for Heavy Salvage in accordance with CMV.](#)

The employer shall ensure that employees are provided with effective and adapted to their distinct tasks education is provided regarding working conditions.

Salvage workers , crane operators, lane protection drivers (collision absorber) , breakdown services , and all other services that have to do with working on the road , this is summarized in :

Global curriculum

During this 5-day course, theory is covered in detail and there are many practical exercises and salvage simulations with real feeders

They also work with a truck crane for the certificate "Working with a Truck Crane" Emergency Vehicles and the certificate "Salvage" .

The training includes a theory and practical part in which the following aspects are covered in detail:

- Safe roadside work according to IM measure
- Laws and regulations
- Safety regulations according to IM measure
- Deliberations and signage according to IM measure
- Inspection of the calamity
- Operation of the truck crane on the emergency vehicle
- Operation of the B 2 Recovery vehicle.
- Loading and unloading vehicles from different accident situations
- Winch techniques
- Breakdown assistance (*no IBKI exam*)
- Emotion and aggression (*no IBKI exam*)
- Emergency response protocols salvage or fire vehicle
- Lifting loads at a truck-mounted crane
- Hand and arm signals
- Inspections and certificates
- Choice of proper winch and lifting tools and equipment
- Communications
- Environmental and safety regulations

In addition, topics covered include:

- Mandatory safety clothing
- Using special lifting devices, human/animal
- Hazardous substances
- Use of personal protective equipment (PPE).
- Road operators and road types
- Dealing with road users
- Installing and removing deposits
- Responsibility and liability

Maximum number of participants

A maximum of 8 participants is possible for this training.

Exam

At the end of the training course, the exam (theory and practice) 'Working with a Truck Crane and Hoist Salvage' is taken by [IBKI](#). This exam takes one day, and can be held at any convenient location if desired.

You will receive the IBKI certificate "Working with a Truck Crane" and the certificate "Salvage" .

In 5 days, this training, officially recognized by Stichting Incident Management Nederland ([SIMN](#)), will provide you with a recognized certificate from the BKS that will demonstrate your quality as a service provider.

If you are also following the IM part of this training, there is an [IBKI](#) exam attached, participants will receive an IM certificate if they pass.
