

Extend ADR basic certificate

Introduction

The transportation of hazardous materials must be done in a safe manner and is governed by numerous legal measures. Drivers must not only know and observe those rules, but must also know what preventive measures to take when loading and unloading. Drivers who transport hazardous materials must hold the ADR certificate.

To remain in possession of a valid ADR certificate, you are required to renew your certificate every five years. You must take a renewal exam to do so. It is illegal to drive with an expired ADR certificate. Has your certificate expired? Then you must take the initial exam for basic ADR and not the renewal exam.

Conditions for extending ADR basic certificate

Target group and admission requirements

Drivers who hold a basic [ADR certificate](#) and wish to renew it

To renew your certificate, you must pass the renewal exam within one year before the expiration date of your certificate

Trainees must not have impairments of vision, hearing functions and motor skills. The student is required to wear a helmet and safety shoes during the practical part of the training.

Content and purpose of training

Participants learn the main legal provisions of the transport of dangerous goods by road and ADR/VLG and are able to apply them. After obtaining the ADR certificate, the competence requirement to transport dangerous goods by road is met.

During the theory section, the following topics will be covered:

- Legal requirements
- Properties of hazardous substances
- Hazard classes of substances
- Vehicle and equipment requirements
- Transportation rules
- Personal Protective Equipment The

practical instruction includes:

- Actions in the event of an accident/ incident
- First aid

Exam

Upon completion, an [exam](#) will be [administered at a CBR location](#).

To participate in the exam, the student MUST have attended every course day The theory exam

lasts 40 minutes and consists of 20 questions
(15 closed questions general and 1 case with 5 questions)

There are also new question types included in the exam You have passed

if you answered 14 or more questions correctly

Code 95 continuing education hours

A maximum of 1 day (7 hours) may be registered for continuing education.

The Class 1 theory course consists of a minimum of 7 clock hours of lessons.
A maximum of 1 day (7 hours) may be registered for continuing education.

The Class 7 theory course consists of a minimum of 7 clock hours of lessons.
A maximum of 1 day (7 hours) may be registered for continuing education.
